

About the talk:

Sarah Baker is considered to be one of the most successful of Georgian theatre impresarios. In 1789 Sarah opened her 'Great Grand Theatre' in Orange Street, the façade of which can still be seen. Making the unlikely transition from strolling player to wealthy entrepreneur, she opened three more purpose-built theatres in the county at Rochester (1791), Maidstone (1798) and Tunbridge Wells (1802).
